We recognise the impact our operations may have on the environment and are committed to minimising and (where practical) preventing pollution. We are committed to complying with applicable legislation and other legal requirements to which RPP subscribes, which relate to our environmental impacts.

We are also fully committed to comply with the requirements of the ISO 14001 Standard and to continually improve the effectiveness of our internal Environmental Management System, covering all areas of our business.

This policy provides a framework for setting and reviewing our environmental objectives and targets. Our current objectives focus on:

1. Carbon and Greenhouse Gas Emissions reduction
2. Sustainable procurement, including promoting responsible sourcing
3. Recycling and re-use initiatives

These objectives are used as a basis to measure and improve our performance ensuring compliance. The Executive Board have overall responsibility for the implementation of this policy. The Group Business Manager acts as the Environmental Management Representative, overseeing all matters.

We have a Carbon and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Plan in place, which is accredited to ISO-14064 and independently audited annually by Achilles. A copy is also published on our [website](#).

As a low impact business, we do not encounter direct incidents, emergencies or complaints in relation to environmental matters. However, should any occur the Group Business Manager will record the event and monitor any ongoing investigations / actions.

All staff have been made aware of their individual responsibility during awareness sessions to take care of themselves, the environment and others to co-operate with the business to fulfil its duties under legislation and this policy.
